### **Provenance and Arrangement**

The Miscellaneous Collection has been added to over the years through donations and purchases. It is hoped the collection will continue to grow in this way. The material is not part of a large, pre-existing collection and therefore has been placed in a miscellaneous collection. Materials in this collection were first organized by accession year (year the archive received the materials), then by alphabetical order. In some cases, additional items located after this initial order were added to the end of the year accessioned.

This finding aid contains a folder level inventory of materials. Each folder is numbered with accession year, and order that the materials were accessioned (i.e. 1988.001). If provenance information was missing, they were assigned the number 1000 for the year. This finding aid lists by these numbers. The majority of folders also contain numbers for individual items if they merited more focused description (i.e. 1988.001.01). This finding aid does not list by these numbers, with the exception of the papers created by the Forel family (1000.367.01-.02 and 1000.367.03-.04). Item level description of all folders is present in an internal collection database powered by PastPerfect. This finding aid does not contain item level description; for further description of individual materials, please contact the library.

### **Restrictions**

A few folders are restricted due to wishes of the family, and HIPAA privacy laws. These include folders 1000.364, and 1980.001. Researchers who wish to publish based on the photocopied

materials related to the Galt family (folder 1000.372) may not do so without permission of the owners of the original materials.

## Scope and Content

Types of materials in this collection include letters, manuscripts, prints, certificates, documents, newspaper and magazine clippings, engravings, prints, photographs, notebooks/letter books, and books. Some of these materials are photocopies or photostats. Most of the papers are from the 19th and 20th centuries, with materials ranging from 1715 to 1977. The collection occupies 4.5 cubic feet (in 2013), with most materials kept in four one cubic foot boxes. The oversized materials are kept in a large print box, or are directly stored on the shelf next to other materials in this collection. Restricted materials are kept in a separate box.
